

# **Lip Sync 2026 Official Rules**

## **“Night at the Disco”**

- 1. Cost to enter is \$20.00 per person and will be paid upon completion of online registration.**
- 2. Each group or contestant will have 3 minutes to set up and take down for their performance. And each song length can be up to 5 minutes or less; no exceptions. And in the event a group or contestant chooses the same song to perform, the group or contestant who gets their entry in first will get to perform that song, the other group or contestant will have to pick a different song from the “Disco” (1970’s) to perform.  
So get your entry in now!**
- 3. All contestants are to remain in the waiting area before performing. Group leader to report to stage right no later than 7:30p on Thursday, May 21st with your props.**
- 4. Points will be awarded from 1 - 10 for each of the following categories:  
A) Costume B) Lip Sync C) Audience Response D) Overall Impression**
- 5. Songs must be submitted with a registration form. Entries are open to Disco (1970’s) theme. Upload music from mp3 with online registration. All recordings must be free of any profanity.**
- 6. Registration forms MUST BE COMPLETED AND TURNED in no later than Monday May 11th, 2026 AT 5:00PM to be entered for the Lip Sync.

- 7. Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup> - \$500 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$300 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$150 and will be determined by the most points.  
Prizes for Adult and Student Divisions.**
- 8. All props will be stored behind the stage area until performance. No open flames, flash pots, or other types of explosives will be allowed. This will result in disqualification.**
- 9. After an act has finished their performance, they must exit from the rear of the stage, No exits or entrances will be made through the audience.**
- 10. Neither Spring Fest and its committee will be responsible for any damage to equipment or cost of lost items.**
- 11. Spring Fest reserves the right to cancel or stop any individual or group performance at any time during the performance in which Spring Fest deems to be inappropriate for any reason, or too lengthy.**
